What To Bring To Camp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please remember to wear/bring the following items each day to camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Closed-toes shoes</li> <li>○ Long pants without rips, (no loose clothing or strapless shirts)</li> <li>○ Long hair to be tied back.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><i>Campers who do not come to camp with the above items may be asked to sit out of activities/workshops if they do not have the proper attire to safely participate.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All additional PPE will be provided when necessary for workshops, however, campers may bring their own safety boots/safety glasses to camp, if they prefer. Items will be inspected by staff to confirm they follow safety requirements for the activity.</li> <li>• Campers are encouraged to bring a change of clothes to wear when not attending workshops, as long pants can be hot to wear all day. Please wear clothing that you are comfortable with getting messy/dirty.</li> <li>• Be sure to bring a hat and sunscreen for outdoor time, as well as water and a packed lunch each day.
