## ADVANCEMENT FROM QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS TO SKILLS ONTARIO COMPETITION

Competitors at the Qualifying Competitions **must achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon and be considered for advancement.

The following numbers of competitors from the Central Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the Skills Ontario Competition, taking place in May in Toronto:

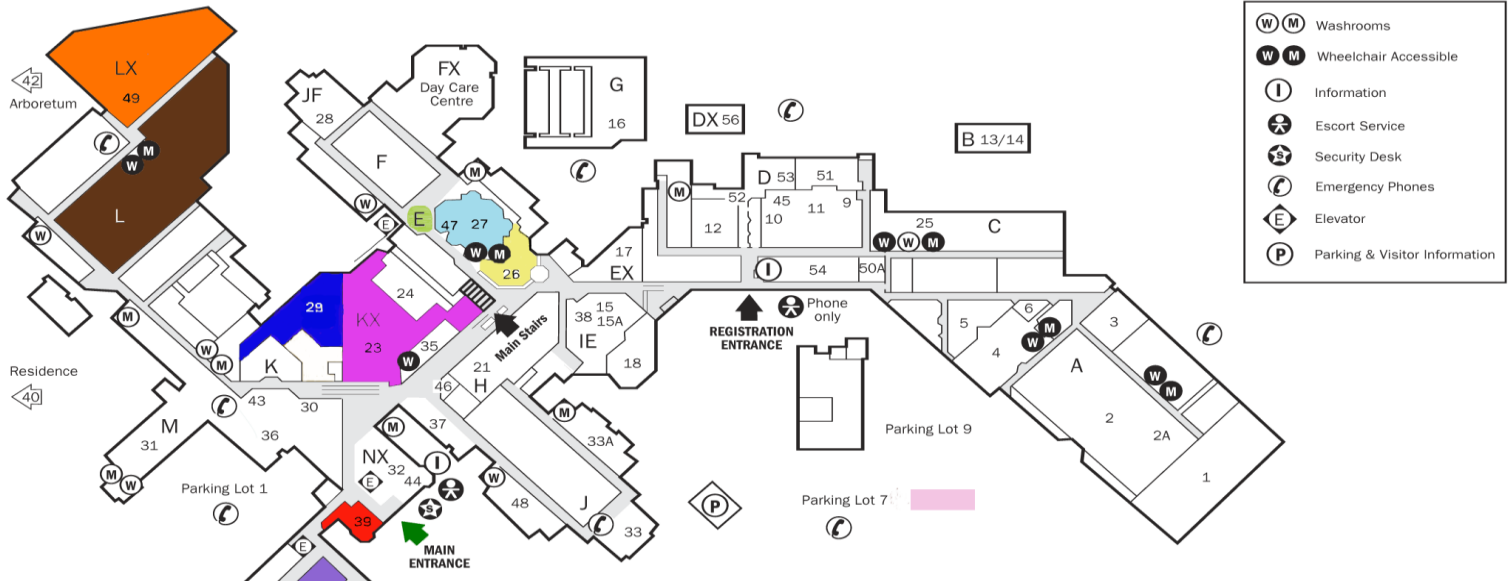
Humber College Institute of Technology North Campus is easily accessible from Highway 401, and the following map will assist participants in locating the campus:

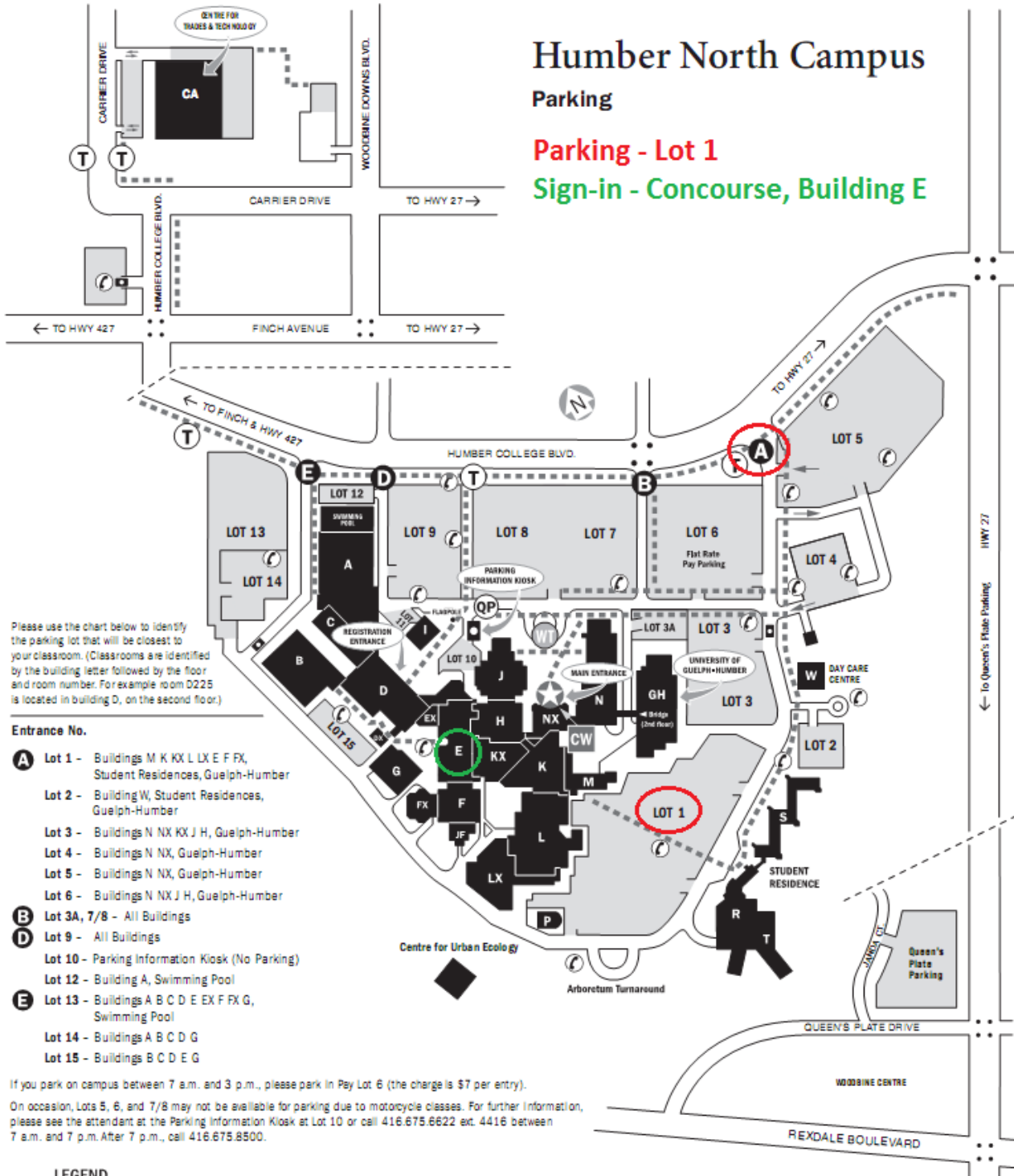
## Humber College North Campus Main Building Floor Plan

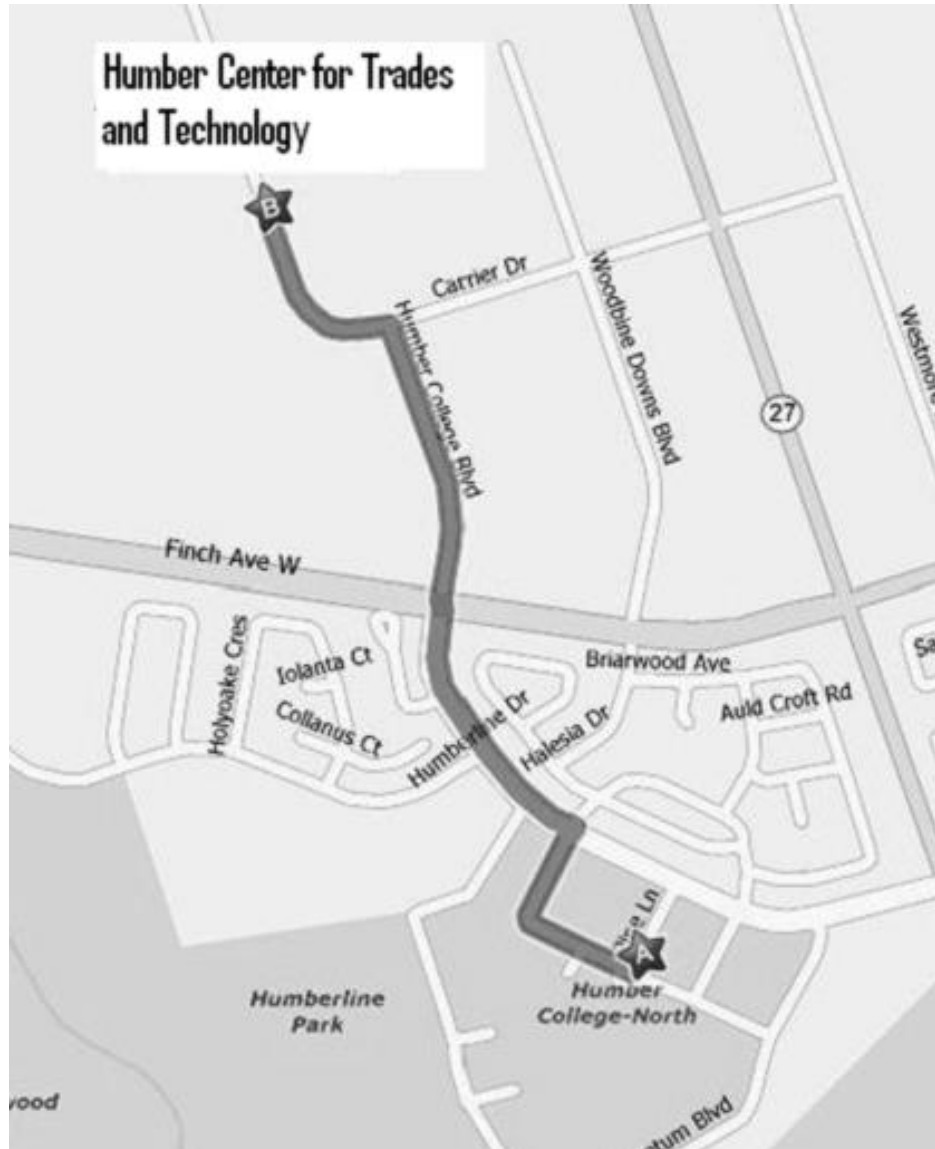

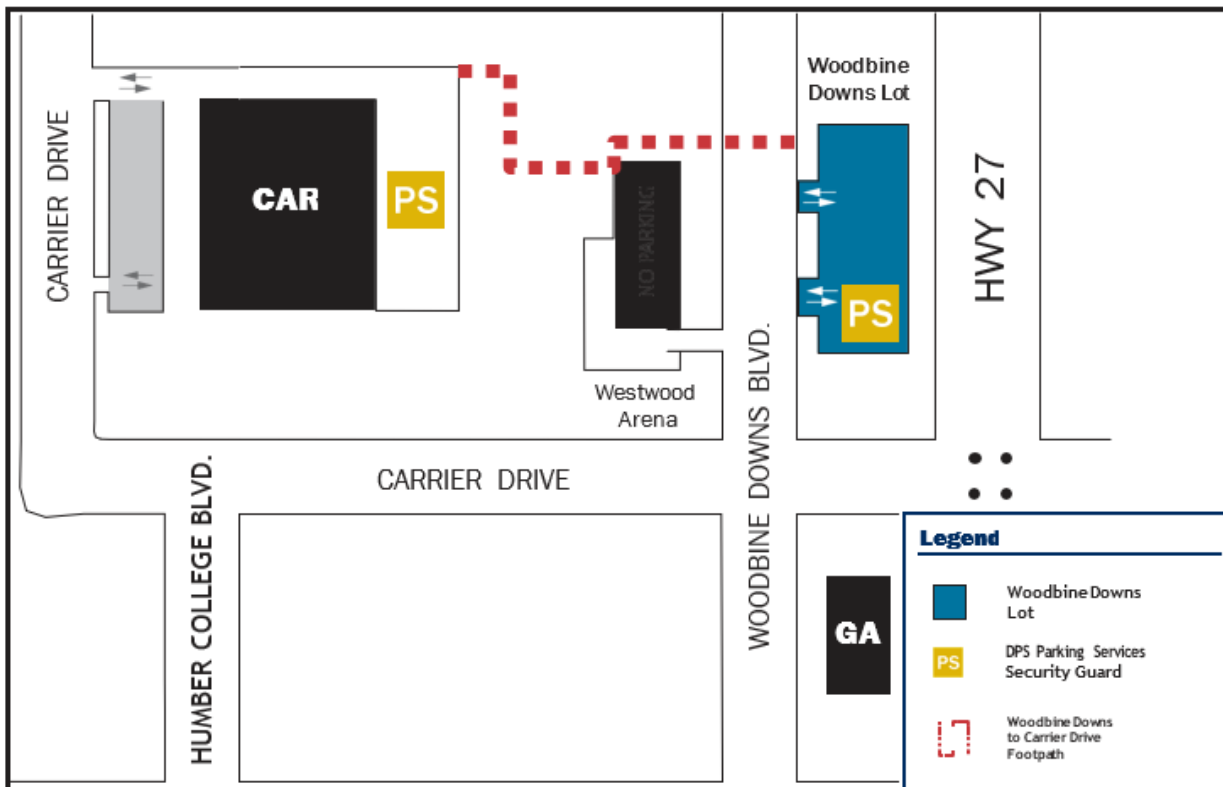

## Directions/Map from North Campus Main Building to Centre for Trades & Technology



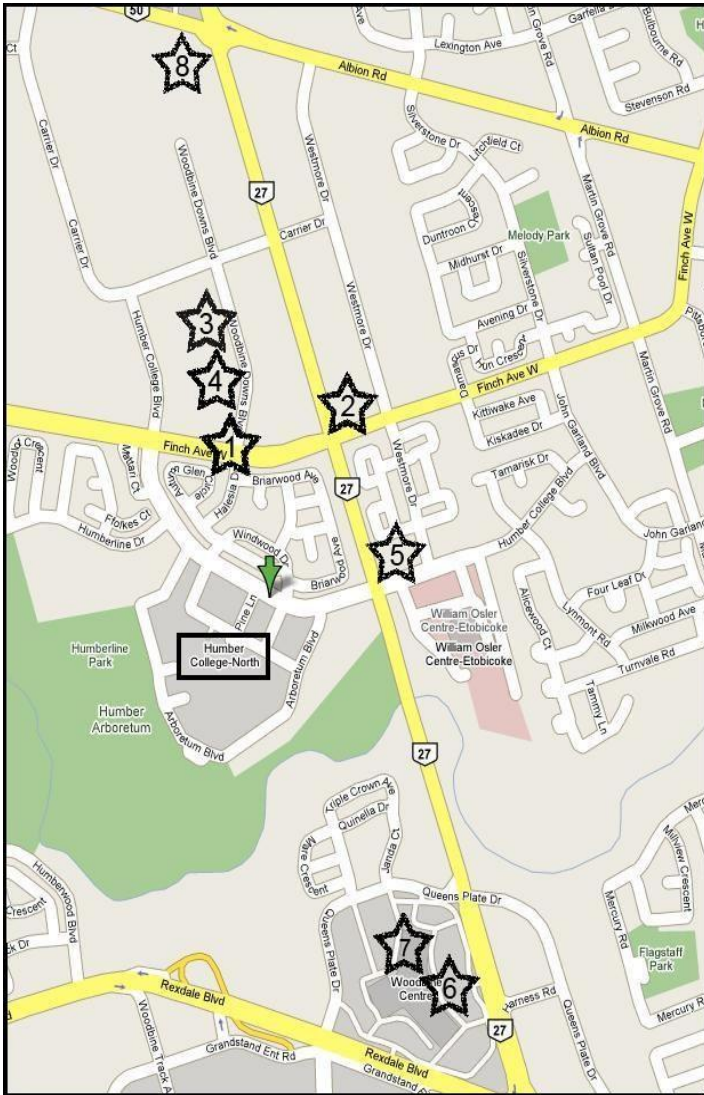
## Parking at the Carrier drive campus (welding)
